Kindergartners can take part in a "Pledge of Allegiance" ceremony, which can be rewarded with an American flag and award certificate. In the eyes of our future leaders, this gesture will mean a lot.

Honor our Prisoners of War and those Missing in Action (say their names). The bravery they showed while serving our country deserves to be recognized. Did you know there are more than 81,000 servicemen and women still unaccounted for? A ceremony should be held on the third Friday of September in their honor with the Missing Man Table.

It is your responsibility as Patriotic Instructor to educate members and ensure proper etiquette within your organization. Explore the Malta/Member resources to learn about the Auxiliary traditions.

Participate in community events. Recognize an outstanding member of the community or a business for taking the time to display the flag of our nation. Families and Auxiliary members should be encouraged to attend and to continue supporting patriotism. Include government officials, law enforcement, and firefighters in the celebration, and recognize their patriotism and dedication.

Take part in the Smart/Maher National Citizenship Education Teacher program. Find out which teacher(s) in your area deserve special recognition for their commitment to teaching Americanism and instilling patriotism in their students with the help of your post members.
