CONTINUING EDUCATION

Open to any VFW Auxiliary member (who has been a member for at least a year), their spouse, son or daughter with a financial need. Entrant must be at least 21 years old, complete the application and submit an essay of 300 words or less.

\$2,250 will be awarded to one applicant in each of the four conferences.

PATRIOTIC ART

Who may enter: Students in grades 9–12 (public, private, parochial, or home school).

Artwork: Original two-dimensional patriotic artwork.

National top scholarship: \$15,000.

3-D ART

Who may enter: Students in grades 9–12.

Artwork: Original 3-dimensional patriotic artwork made from materials such as clay, wood, metal, fabric, pottery, paper, etc.

Not accepted: Digital art, photography, jewelry, weapons, or 3-D printed art.

National top scholarship: \$2,500, with national awards totaling \$5,500.
